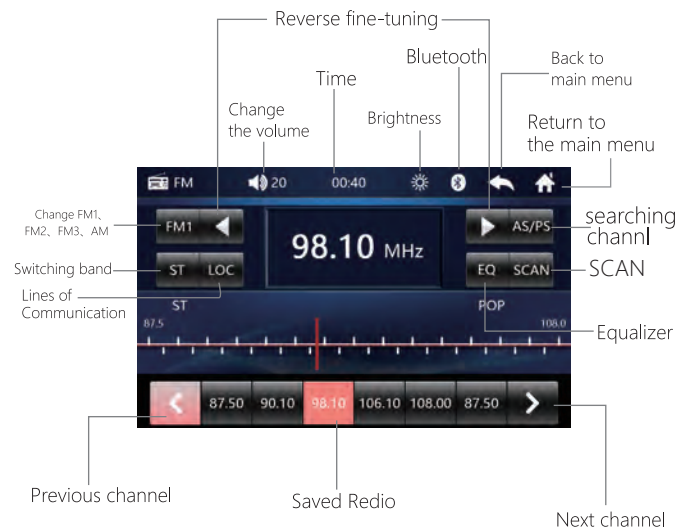
**Note: Please reading this before installing.**

- If not connect its cables correctly , it may destroy the machine or the car electronic system.
- Speaker cables must be connected with the car speaker cables
- and do not connected the car body. Make sure all cables are connected correctly before switch on the machine.
- When you change the fuse , must get the same size to change
- Do not block the air wholes and heating panel, otherwise it will get fire.
- After install the machine , please press RESET to reset it as the beginning using.
- First, do not turn off when not installed.
- Do not install under 18 years of age.
- Wear gloves when installing the product to avoid scratches.

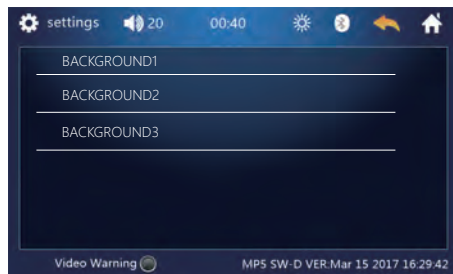

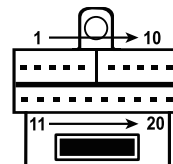


## Instructions

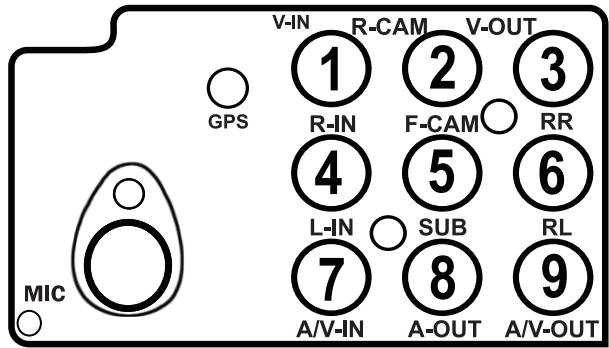

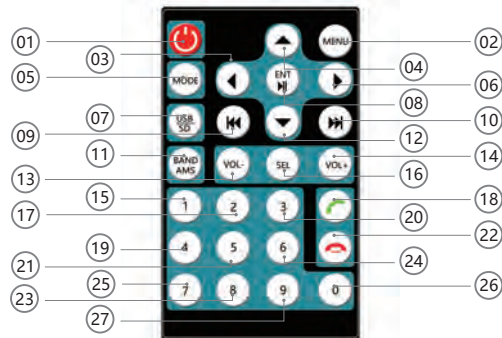
### A. Common troubleshooting guide.

TROUBLE	REASON	THE SOLUTION
Can't boot up	Power fuse burn out	Replace with the same fuse
	Other factors causing microprocessor operation is not correct	Press the RST on the drawing board in a sharp things, then restart
Ignition switch is turned off,all information is lost	Ignition line ACC and the positive power line batt is connected to the wrong	exchange the line and rewiring
The remote control doesn't work	Battery power on the remote control is not enough	Replace the battery
Poor reception	Did not put the antenna outside The ground Antenna is poor connect	Check whether the radio automatic antenna ANT had connect. To check the antenna. Whether the ground wire is connected
Unable to convert language/subtitles	Disc only have a language/subtitle	Only a language/subtitle, so it can't convert
